







Goal Setting Procedures


(Life is NOT a beer commercial!)

- Formalization (write them down)
- Evaluation (New Years Eve)
- Modification (time wasters)





How to Achieve Your Goals

Claim what is Yours




- Don't be afraid to ask for merited raises or promotions

Solicit Feedback Regularly


- Get honest feedback from colleagues, managers, and subordinates

- Be open to change





- Don't Limit yourself!!


